Position Paper

1. General Comment:

We are pleased to see that the Measures for the Administration of the National Professional Standardization Technical Committee (draft) take full account of the capacity building and supervision of the Technical Standards Committee, the broadness and representativeness of the members.

However, in view of the problems exposed in the actual work of the standard committee, such as some individual secretariat units take advantage of the existing status, and in this way the spirit of open, fair and transparent in standards development are not fully implemented, we hope that through the development of this management measures, in the next specific work,

- 1) continue to be open and transparent, and earnestly implement the relevant spirit of "People's Republic of China Standardization Law" and "People's Republic of China Standardization Law Implementation Regulations," and make the specific terms more operational, feasibility and efficiency,
- 2) advocate good behavior practices

so that to make sure the standards are developed in a more scientific, rational and efficient manner.
